Class E Commercial, business and service	Use, or part use, for all or any of the following purposes: (a) For the display or retail sale of goods, other than hot food, principally to visiting members of the public (b) For the sale of food and drink principally to visiting members of the public where consumption of that food and drink is mostly undertaken on the premises. (c) For the provision of the following kinds of services principally to visiting members of the public. (i) Financial services, (ii) Professional services (other than health or medical services), or (iii) Any other services which it is appropriate to provide in a commercial, business or service locality (d) For indoor sport, recreation or fitness, not involving motorised vehicles or firearms, principally to visiting members of the public. Temporary Change of Use	<p>Any building in any Use Class (not including Sui Generis) and any land within its curtilage, except use class F2, can be used as a state-funded school for up to 2 academic years, with limitations and conditions, including that the site must be approved by the Secretary of State with responsibility for schools.</p> <p>Vacant use class C1, C2, C2A, or E land (with all buildings demolished) may be developed to provide temporary school buildings, and the land used as a state-funded school for up to 3 academic years, subject to prior approval, and with limitations and conditions, including that the building must be removed at the end of the third academic year.</p> <p>Betting office, pay day loan shop, hot food takeaway or Class E can change to a flexible use falling within Class E, Class F1(b) (display of art), Class F1(c) museum, Class F1(d) (public library or public reading room); or Class F1(e) (public hall or exhibition hall), for up to three years continuously, for areas up to 150sqm.</p>
